

## **CORRECTED ANNOUNCEMENT**

### **White Mountain Apache Housing Authority PUBLIC NOTICE:**

*The purpose of this announcement is to inform citizens of the White Mountain Apache Tribe of the availability of funds for which the White Mountain Apache Housing Authority (WMAHA) is announcing its intention to apply to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for a fiscal year 2018 Indian Community Development Block Grant (ICDBG) to conduct moderate rehabilitation on up to 35 housing units in Whiteriver, Az. ICDBG is a competitive grant program offered through the HUD Office of Native American Programs that can be used for housing rehabilitation, housing acquisition, new housing construction, land acquisition to support new housing, homeownership assistance, public facilities and improvements, economic development, and microenterprise programs, and must principally benefit low- and moderate-income persons as defined at 24 CFR 2001.4. White Mountain is eligible to apply for up to \$2 million in ICDBG funds in the fiscal year 2018 funding round, and applications are due January 7, 2019.*

*The WMAHA invites community members to review and comment on its performance under its previous ICDBG grant and on the proposed project at a community meeting on **Monday, December 3, 2018 @ 1:00 p.m.** at the Fort Apache Building.
